### **OPEN SESSION**

#### Agenda Item 1 - Call to Order / Roll Call / Establishment of Quorum

The meeting was called to order at 2 PM. Executive Officer Andy Foster called roll. Commissioner Hendrickson was absent. All Commissioners in attendance joined via WebEx.

<u>Agenda Item 2</u> - Discussion and Possible Action regarding Bare Knuckle Fighting Championship Request for a Promoter License in order to hold events using Bare Knuckle Fighting Rules pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 4, Section 533

The Commission discussed extending the trial period for bare knuckle fighting events. The Commission has observed a decrease in drug test failures at bare knuckle fighting events. The Commission will continue monitoring drug testing and compliance by the fighters. Some commissioners expressed concerns about the safety and integrity of bare knuckle fighting as a sport. Dr. Wallace, founding member of the Association of Ringside Physicians, has extensive experience in combat sports and spoke to various states that held BKFC events and found that the number of serious injuries (hospitalizations, deaths) that occurred was low. Vice Chair Dr. Williams mentioned data he had seen that suggested that the number of concussive head injuries were reduced due to lacerations that ended the fights early. Dr. Wallace added that he noticed the occurrence of hand injuries was also reduced. The Association of Ringside Physicians is currently collecting data on bare knuckle fighting injuries.

Commissioner Gruwell *moved* to grant BKFC a temporary license for 6 events or one year, whichever comes first. The promoter and the event data from California shall then be reviewed by the Commission.

Commissioner Dr. De Mars seconded the motion.

Tom Martinez stated that if approved he would like to hold an event at the State fairgrounds.

Motion passed 5-1 by roll call vote.
