




#### PM3 | Intake & Investigation


Average cycle time from complaint receipt to closure of the investigation process. Does not include cases sent to the Attorney General or other forms of formal discipline.



Target Average: 60 Days | Actual Average: 44 Days

#### PM4 | Formal Discipline


Average number of days to complete the entire enforcement process for cases resulting in formal discipline. (Includes intake and investigation by the Board and prosecution by the AG).



**Target Average:** 540 Days | **Actual Average:** 548 Days

## **PM7** | Probation Intake


Average number of days from monitor assignment, to the date the monitor makes first contact with the probationer.



Target Average: 10 Days | Actual Average: 20 Days

## **PM8 | Probation Violation Response**

Average number of days from the date a violation of probation is reported, to the date the assigned monitor initiates appropriate action.



Target Average: 10 Days | Actual Average: 12 Days
