



# **Enforcement Performance Measures**








#### PM3 | Investigations - Volume

(Includes intake and investigation)




Target Average: 270 Days | Actual Average: 187 Days

#### PM4 | Formal Discipline - Volume




# PM4 | Formal Discipline – Cycle Time<sup>2</sup>


