

Number of complaints and convictions received.



PM2 | Intake - Cycle Time


Average number of days from complaint receipt, to the date the complaint was closed or assigned to an investigator.

PM4 | Formal Discipline - Volume




PM4 | Formal Discipline - Cycle Time

PM7 | Probation Intake – Cycle Time


Average number of days from monitor assignment, to the date the monitor makes first contact with the probationer.

PM8 | Probation Violation Response - Volume


Number of probation violation cases.
